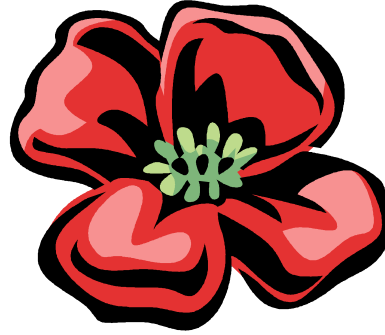
**STUDENT LED PARENT CONFERENCES**

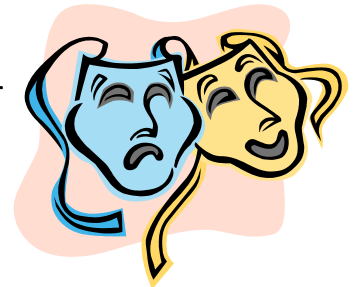


Host Families Needed
