**Old Business**

- a) Camp Chief Hector (Grades 4-6) – put in spring 2019 dates, but still haven't heard back. Will look into or possibly another camp. Milo Agricultural Society sponsors.
- b) Marine Biology Trip (Bluewater Adventures) Grades 7-9 – possibly spring 2020 or Kerry will see if Champion school needs additional students for their trip in spring 2019. Also need to secure a teacher that can go on the trip. Will schedule a separate Marine Biology meeting for those parents/students. Can possibly apply for Milo School Foundation casino funding, but will need to apply by spring 2019 for funds.

**Principal's Report: Mrs. Kerry Aiken**

- a) *2018/2019 Yearend Awards* – no learner profile awards. Discussed Top Student awards vs. Top Student per subject (social, L.A.) awards. Awards monthly or Quarterly rather than just only at yearend. Staff will discuss and come up with ideas.
- b) *Teaching Schedule & CRM (Collaborative Response Model)*. Teachers teaching classes to match their strengths. Quincy – Literacy, Jared PE & math, etc. Kerry taking LLI (Leveled Literacy Intervention) training in October. Students will get broken into literacy, math groups based on skills. Takes time to implement and will hopefully be using system by November.
- c) *Monthly Staff Meetings* –volunteers again willing to supervise lunch breaks so ALL staff can have a monthly staff meeting. Preferably Thursdays so Frank Sitting Eagle (Siksika Liason) can join.  
**Supervisors x 4 needed for first meeting Thursday October 11 Noon.**
- d) Junior ATB program. Cannot run at this time due to lack of staff and time to offer program.
- e) *PAT Results* from last year – can access and print results end of September and send information home with those students who did the PAT tests last year.
- f) ***Nutrition Update:*** Frances Thompson is running the program, 10 hours per week. Frances does a great job and also teaches the kids about nutrition. Discussed milk program and decided to offer milk every Thursday (when Frances not there). Kerry will send out google survey for parents to choose between white or chocolate milk. Not ready for Thursday lunches yet.
- g) ***Options Classes*** – 40 minutes every Thursday starting October 11 to November report card time, then starting again in January- March. Students chose their top three options (sewing, cooking, Blackfoot, drama, indoor games, leadership, yearbook, etc.) Robotics wasn't offered as Tammy is working on sorting and cleaning robotics kits. Jana offered curling as an option for January?
