- a) 2019/20 Staff update. 4 full time teachers again. Not sure on Aides, have meeting later in June.
- b) 2019 Christmas Production booked Trickster Theater for December 16-19. “Winter in Canada now & then”. Applied for Alberta Artists and Education Grant which would possibly cover 75% of the cost. Cost is approx. \$12,500 x 25% = \$3,125. If don’t get grant Trickster Theater offers a Plan B where you could get a discount of 50% off. Cost would them be \$5,775.
- c) Nutrition grant, will use to buy burgers for last day of school. Colleen Bartsch donated last year and bought 3 boxes at RCWC x 40 = 120 burgers. Kerry will order. Parents will make sauce and cook burgers. Extra BBQ at curling rink.
- d) Will sign up next year for Back to School for ordering school supplies. Parents order online and supplies are sent to school in the fall.

- e) Garden Watering in Summer. Hose Faucet was frozen this spring and needs to be replaced. Possible that someone has been stealing water from the school as Palliser cannot find a leak (school, Palliser and Village looking into). Need to hide the hoses or put a lockbox or something on the hose faucet. Kerry has Palliser looking into lockbox. Jana will make a calendar sign up sheet for summer watering if the facet is fixed. Or maybe put a timer on if can find a way to have it locked up. If facet is not fixed, will have to find alternatives for watering.
