


# Milo Community School Council Meeting Wednesday March 16, 2022

## Palliser Report: Lorelei Bexte See attached for full report

- Tech department goal was to have one Chromebook for every 2 students in Palliser schools. Palliser has no surpassed that with students having access to approx. 6800 Chromebooks.
- Alberta School Council Engagement Grant, each school council will receive \$500 to better support individual school councils and strengthen engagement with parents.
- Between February 25 and May 2022, Advanis Inc. has been contracted to conduct the annual satisfaction telephone/online surveys for the Ministry of Education to collect public and participant perceptions of Alberta's education system. Recommend doing survey.
- In 2021, the Palliser School Division Family School Liaison Counselling Program team increased from nine to 18 members consisting of full-time and part-time counsellors, externally funded counsellors and practicum students. Kerry and Quincy discussed with Lorelei on how to gain access to a counselor for Milo School, as the counsellor assigned to our school is now on leave.
